Notes: \* Marketplace data represent the cumulative number of Individuals Determined Eligible to Enroll in a plan Through the Marketplace who have selected a plan from 10-1-13 to 3-31-14, including Special Enrollment Period-related activity through 4-19-14 (with or without the first premium payment having been received directly by the Marketplace or the issuer), excluding plan selections with unknown data for a given metric. Minnesota plan selection totals do not include adults between 133% and 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) because these individuals are enrolled in the MinnesotaCare program. In addition, children up to 275% FPL are covered through the Medicaid program. Hence, when comparing Minnesota's cumulative data for these indicators with other State-Based Marketplaces, the number of individuals determined eligible for MinnesotaCare and enrolled in MinnesotaCare are worth noting. Because of challenges in aggregating across manual and electronic enrollments, Minnesota does have a consolidated source for reporting subsidies/CSRs at this time. At this time, Minnesota is unable to provide age, gender, and metal level breakouts for manual enrollments. The 'unknown' data referred to in the demographic and metal level tables refer to enrollments that are manually processed.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Medicaid/CHIP data are state reported and represent the difference between March 2014 enrollment and Pre-ACA Monthly Average Medicaid and CHIP Enrollment (July-Sept 2013). Not all changes in enrollment may be related to the Affordable Care Act. Because these data are state-reported, detailed questions about the Medicaid/CHIP data should be directed to the states. As of the end of 2013, the Minnesota covered approximately 84,000 individuals under an early expansion under the Affordable Care Act, most of whom are not captured in the change in Medicaid/CHIP enrollment figure above because they were already enrolled in the "baseline" period (July-September 2013).
