The next meeting of the Advisory Council on Alzheimer's Research, Care, and Services will be held on Monday, October 30 from 12pm to 4:30pm EST. The meeting will be a virtual and will stream live on <a href="http://www.hhs.gov/live">http://www.hhs.gov/live</a>.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to a lapse in appropriations, the government is currently shut down. If the government is not opened and fully operational by Thursday, October 19, the meeting will be postponed to Monday, November 13. The meeting agenda and format (virtual) will be the same.
