

Listening Sessions to Inform the National Plan to Address Alzheimer's Disease

We invite you to participate in a public listening session, hosted by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), to help inform the [National Plan to Address Alzheimer's Disease](#). Listening sessions will bring together healthcare providers, researchers, advocates, private sector partners, and state, local, and Tribal officials, as well as people living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias (ADRD) and their caregivers or care partners. Participants will have the opportunity to share insights, identify emerging needs, and discuss strategies to strengthen the nation's response to ADRD.

The listening sessions will focus on topics such as:

- Improving care and support for people living with ADRD and their caregivers or care partners
- Advancing research and therapeutic development and translating scientific discoveries into effective treatments and care
- Improving risk reduction and brain health across the lifespan
- Strengthening the workforce and infrastructure needed to support research and therapeutic development, risk reduction activities, health and long-term care delivery, and caregiver support
- Improving early detection and timely diagnosis of ADRD
