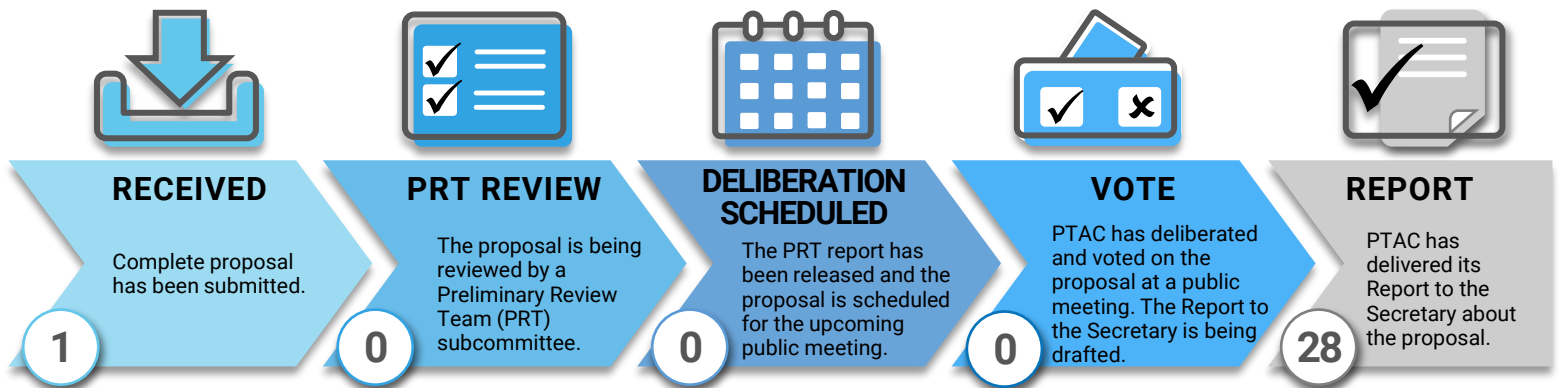


THE PROPOSAL REVIEW PROCESS
